ORAL ARGUMENT



- 1) NOTICE OF APPEAL filed with district court clerk; jurisdictional deadline, due within 30 days after entry of judgment or order
- 2) REPRESENTATION STATEMENT (Form 6) filed in district court concurrently with, and attached to, notice of appeal
- 3) CIVIL CASE MEDIATION QUESTIONNAIRE (Form 7) filed in 9th Cir; due within 7 days after a civil appeal is docketed
- 4) TRANSCRIPT DESIGNATION FORM filed in district court; due within 30 days of the filing of the notice of appeal
- 5) APPELLANT'S OPENING BRIEF due within 40 days after record files
 - > EXCERPTS OF RECORD filed concurrently with opening brief
- 6) APPELLEE'S BRIEF due within 30 days after opening brief is filed
 - SUPPLEMENTAL EXCERPTS OF RECORD (if necessary) filed concurrently with respondent's brief
- 7) REPLY BRIEF due within 21 days after appellee's brief is filed
 - > FURTHER EXCERPTS OF RECORD (if necessary) filed concurrently with reply brief
 - > EXTENSION REQUESTS for each brief, streamlined extension available up to 30-days; further requests via motion due at least 7 days before expiration of the time prescribed for filing the brief
 - > MOTION TO DISMISS can be filed before or after the record has been docketed in 9th Cir.
- 8) ORAL ARGUMENT argument cases are assigned to their respective panels about 12 weeks before oral argument
 - > TIME/PLACE about 10 weeks before oral argument, the parties are notified of the time and place of the hearing

- 9) WRITTEN OPINION, MEMORANDUM OR ORDER no time limit, but most cases are decided within 3 months to a year
 - > REQUEST FOR PUBLICATION must be received within 60 days of the issuance of the court's disposition; parties have 14 days from the date of service to notify the Court of any objections they may have to the publication of the disposition
 - > REQUEST FOR PANEL REHEARING/REHEARING EN BANC petition for rehearing due within 14 days after the appellate court's judgment
 - > ISSUANCE OF MANDATE court issues within 7 days after expiration of time for filing a petition for rehearing, unless a petition for rehearing or a motion to stay the mandate is filed, or the time period is shortened or enlarged by court order
- 10) PETITION FOR CERTIORARI filed in US Supreme Court; due within 90 days after 9th Cir. enters judgment
 - a) BRIEF IN OPPOSITION to Petition for Certiorari due within 30 days after the case is placed on the docket
 - b) REPLY BRIEF Court will not wait for reply

- 1) NOTICE OF APPEAL filed in Superior Court; jurisdictional deadline, due within 60/180 days
- 2) NOTICE DESIGNATING RECORD ON APPEAL filed in Superior Court; due within 10 days of filing appeal
- 3) CIVIL CASE INFORMATION STATEMENT filed in Court of Appeal; due within 15 days of filing appeal
- 4) CERTIFICATE OF INTERESTED ENTITIES/PERSONS filed in Court of Appeal; due any time before or concurrently with 1st filing
- 5) APPELLANT'S OPENING BRIEF due 40 days after record files (plus grace period of at least 15 days)
 - > APPELLANT'S APPENDIX (or joint appendix) filed concurrently with opening brief (unless Clerk's Transcript designated)
- 6) RESPONDENT'S BRIEF due 30 days after opening brief is filed (plus grace period of at least 15 days)
 - > RESPONDENT'S APPENDIX (if necessary) filed concurrently with respondent's brief
- 7) REPLY BRIEF due 20 days after respondent's brief is filed (no grace period)
 - > EXTENSION REQUESTS for any brief, up to 60 days via stipulation, or via court application showing good cause
 - > MOTION TO DISMISS can be filed before or after the record is filed in Court of Appeal
 - > MOTION TO AUGMENT OR CORRECT THE RECORD can be filed at any time

8) **ORAL ARGUMENT** – usually scheduled between 3 and 12 months after last brief is filed, depending on size of the record and complexity of the case

- 9) WRITTEN OPINION can be published (precedential), or unpublished (nonprecedential) issued within 90 days after oral argument
 - > REQUEST FOR ORDER TO PUBLISH an unpublished opinion can be requested by anybody from the Court of Appeal; due within 20 days after the opinion is filed
 - > REQUEST FOR ORDER TO DE-PUBLISH an opinion certified for publication can be requested from CA Supreme Court by anybody; due within 30 days after decision is final in Court of Appeal
 - > PETITION FOR REHEARING due within 15 days after opinion is filed
 - > FINALITY The Court of Appeal's opinion becomes FINAL 30 days after opinion is filed
- 10) PETITION FOR REVIEW filed in CA Supreme Court; due within 10 days after Court of Appeal's opinion becomes final
 - a) ANSWER to Petition for Review due 20 days after petition is filed
 - b) REPLY due 10 days after Answer is filed
- 11) REMITTITUR issued by Court of Appeal after time to seek Supreme Court review expires or review is denied
